We have a safe recruitment process for those people who volunteer to work with children and vulnerable adults. Volunteers are required to attend a training course every three years.

As the church council are responsible for the safeguarding, every member is required to fill in a confidential declaration form and attend a training course.

As required by our insurance, activities with children and vulnerable adults, helpers have to be agreed by the church council every year. The safeguarding policy is reviewed every year.

The Health and Safety policy is revised at regular intervals as we are aware of our responsibilities to everyone using the building. We also rely on everyone to use best practice at all times.
